

## Kiwanis Cal-Nev-Ha Foundation President's Report

Dear Board Members,

Non-restrictive fund raising has shown a sufficient increase over the past couple years which is a good sign. Still, we are far short of meeting our budgetary needs, which has caused us to trim back in several areas, mostly grant awarding. We are hopeful for continued increase in our fund-raising effort that will allow us to restore most of the trimmed programs. A lot will depend on our District stepping up their award donations. We are in line to award a record number of DSA's this year. If we can receive an increase in Dunlap, CSA's, Tablet of Honors, along with donations through the Champions for Children programs, we may make up a good portion of the budget cuts.

The sustaining fund raising program is close to be introduced. Final adjustments are being made to the implementation of the program. We are planning on revealing the Program at the District Convention for full implementation on October 1, 2019.

The Foundation board approved an increase in donation for DSA's and CSA's beginning in October. The donation will increase to \$200 for these awards effective October 1, 2019. Please advise the clubs within your regions so they will be able to budget for the increase.

We are still promoting the "Dinner Anywhere" raffle. There are a limited number of tickets remaining. Don't be left out. Tickets for the Aloha Tribute quilt remain on sale. Both will be awarded at the District Convention.

I want to express my thanks to the Kiwanis Cal-Nev-Ha Foundation board who have really stepped it up in addressing our finances this year. Things are moving in the right direction.
