Ways to Give. . .



One-time Gift -- make a quick and easy one-time gift now.



Monthly Gift -- the gift that keeps giving. Give a little every month makes a big difference. Become a sustaining donor by making an automated monthly gift.

Matching Gifts -- check with your employer to see if they may match your donation doubling the impact.

Volunteer Grant Gifts -- many corporations provide monetary grants to organizations where their employees volunteer regularly.

Tribute Giving -- honor a loved one, a mentor or someone you admire with a gift in his or her name. Pay tribute to the special people in your life with a tribute or memorial gift.

Planned Giving -- make a charitable gift of at least \$1,000 through your will or trust and be enrolled in the Foundation's "Legacy Fellowship" program.

Fellowship Giving -- make a gift of \$500 or more annually and be recognized for your generosity as a member of the Foundation's "Visionary Fellowship" program.

Legacy Fellowship

Visionary Fellowship

Visionary Fellowship donors are organizations, individuals and Kiwanis clubs who make cumulative gifts of \$500 or more during the Foundation's fiscal year (October 1 - September 30). See following page for details to each Fellowship.

Cumulative Giving

Only outright gifts of cash, securities, and irrevocable planned gifts, or outright pledges of cash, securities, and gifts in-kind to the YES! Fund are included in the cumulative giving totals for Fellowship Giving. The overall pledge is counted toward one's total giving -- not individual pledge payments.

We are unable to include unrealized planned gifts in cumulative giving totals.

Trailblazer Fellow -- (\$8,500 - \$14,999)

- Recognized at the annual Gala and Honors Breakfast programs
- Invitations to special events, scholarship and check presentations
- One-time Commemorative Brick at the Kiwanis Professional Center's Visionary Fellowship designated section



Leadership Fellow -- (\$15,000 - \$24,999)

All of the Trailblazer Circle benefits, plus:

- Visionary Fellowship lapel pin as a Leadership Fellow (1 pin for an individual; 20 pins for a club or organization)
- Recognition on the Donor Wall at the Kiwanis Professional Center
- Scholarship Naming (starting at \$10,000 and in increments of \$10,000)
- Banner recognition at Mid-Year Conferences and District Convention



Elite Fellow -- (\$25,000+)



All of the Leadership Circle benefits, plus:

- Visionary Fellowship lapel pin as an Elite Fellow (1 pin for an individual; 25 pins for a club or organization)
- Special holiday gift from the Foundation
- VIP seating at the annual Gala and Honors Breakfast
- Invitation to attend a private reception with the Foundation President
