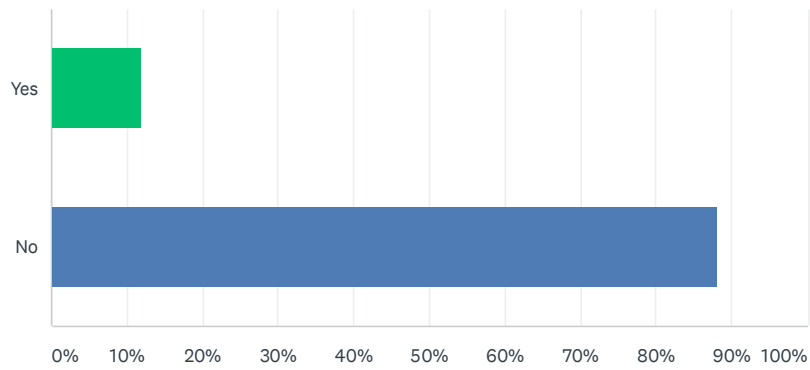

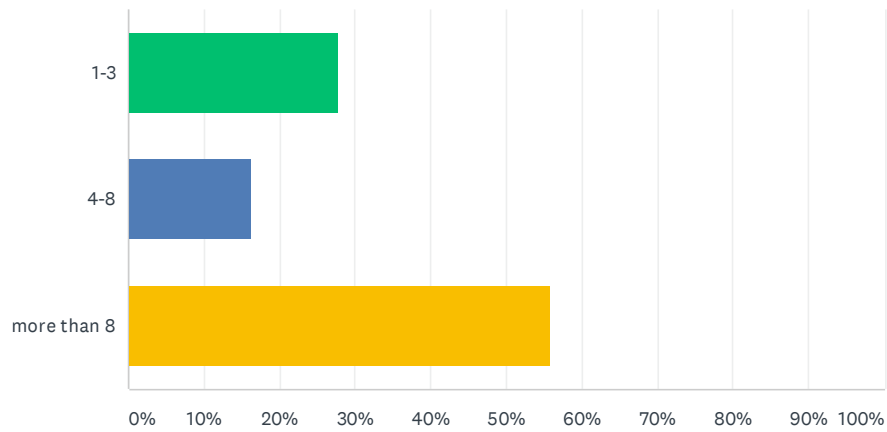

## Q2 If this was not your first Mid-Year Education Conference, how many have you attended in the past?

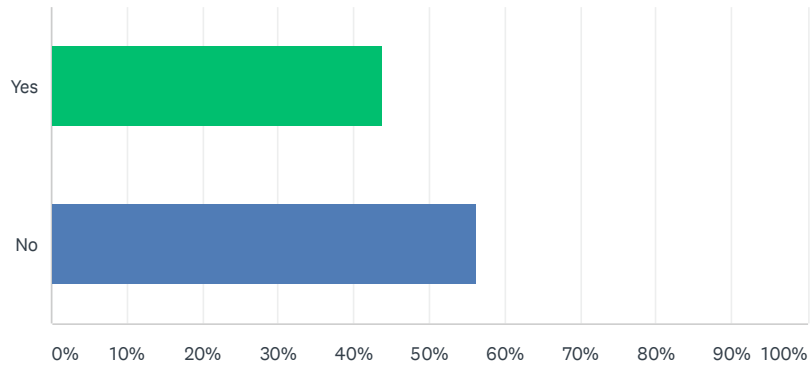

### Q3 Did your spouse/partner attend the conference with you?

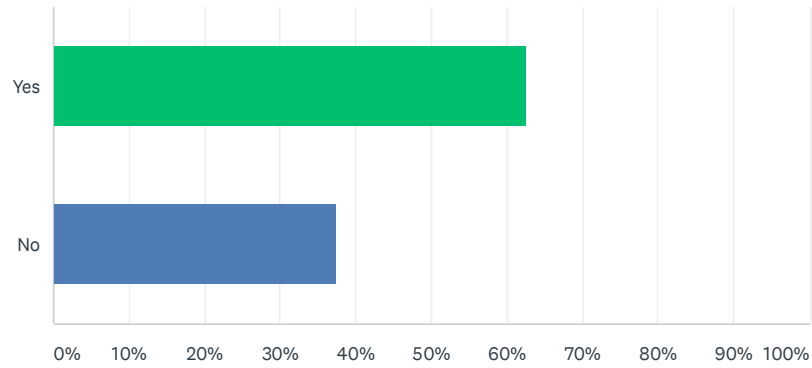

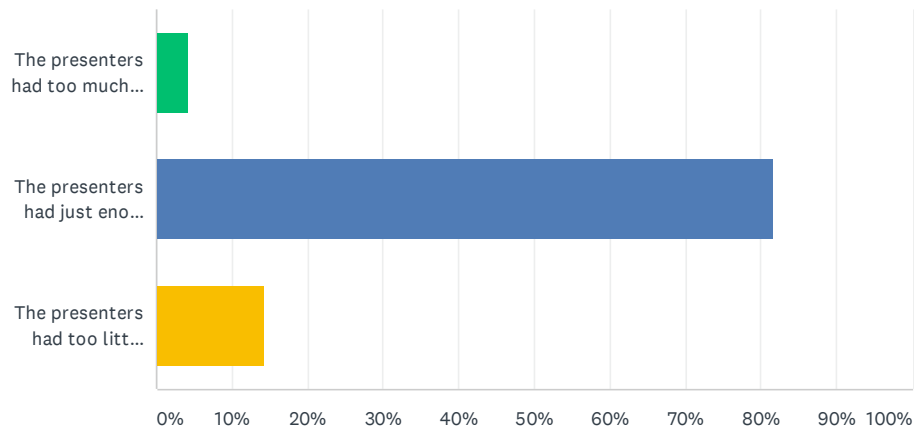
