<4 SLP SCHOLARSHIPS>

PAST GOVERNOR KENNETH C. FORROR, M.D., ESTABLISHED A SCHOLARSHIP FUND IN 1980 TO ASSIST SLP MEMBERS IN THE CAL-NEV-HA DISTRICT.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IS GIVEN TO A SELECTED NUMBER OF STUDENTS WHO HAVE DEMONSTRATED EXCEPTIONAL LEADERSHIP, SERVICE TO THEIR SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY, ACADEMIC ABILITY AND

HAVE BEEN ACTIVE MEMBERS OF A KEY CLUB, KIWIN'S OR CIRCLE K CLUB.

IN 2019-2020 YOUR GENEROSITY AWARDED MORE THAN \$144,000 IN SCHOLARSHIPS TO THESE STUDENT LEADERS.

<5 SLP LEADERSHIP TRAINING>

THE CAL-NEV-HA CHILDREN'S FUND ALSO PROVIDES FOR THE HOUSING, FOOD AND TRANSPORTATION COSTS FOR EVERY DISTRICT SLP LEADER TO ATTEND THEIR BOARD MEETINGS AND TRAININGS,

ENSURING EVERY STUDENT HAS THE OPPORTUNITY TO SERVE ON THEIR DISTRICT BOARD, REGARDLESS OF THEIR FAMILY'S ABILITY TO PAY.

THANKS TO YOU, WE INVESTED MORE THAN \$33,000 TO THESE STUDENT LEADERS IN 2019-2020.

<7 CLUB GRANTS>

WE HAVE CLUB GRANTS AVAILABLE TO ASSIST CLUBS IN FINANCING NEW CLUB

SERVICE PROJECTS BY PROVIDING START-UP FUNDS, UP TO 25% OF THE CLUB'S TOTAL MONETARY CONTRIBUTION TO THE TOTAL PROJECT COST, WITH A MAXIMUM OF \$1,500.00 PER PROJECT.

<8 PTP CLUB GRANTS>

WE ALSO HAVE PEDIATRIC TRAUMA PROGRAM GRANTS TO ASSIST KIWANIS CLUBS, DIVISIONS AND SERVICE LEADERSHIP PROGRAMS IN FINANCING NEW SERVICE PROJECTS WHICH ADDRESS PEDIATRIC TRAUMA AND INJURY PREVENTION.

<9 PTP SLP GRANTS>

AND FOR OUR SLP CLUBS, A SINGLE SLP CLUB CAN RECEIVE START-UP FUNDS, UP TO \$500 PER PROJECT, WITH NO MATCHING FUNDS REQUIRED FROM THE SLP CLUB.

<10 PARTNER HOSPITAL GRANTS>

OUR PARTNER HOSPITAL GRANT PROGRAM PROVIDES GRANTS TO A SELECT GROUP OF CHILDREN'S HOSPITALS TO MEET THEIR UNFUNDED

NEEDS WHICH ARE DIRECTLY RELATED TO PEDIATRIC TRAUMA.

<11 DISASTER GRANTS>

OUR DISASTER ASSISTANCE GRANTS ASSIST KIWANIANS AND THEIR CLUBS IN PROVIDING IMMEDIATE DISASTER RELIEF ASSISTANCE IN THE EVENT OF A NATURAL DISASTER. GRANTS OF UP TO \$500 PER PROJECT MAY BE AWARDED TO A KIWANIS CLUB WITH NO MATCHING FUNDS REQUIRED FROM THE CLUB.

<12 COVID-19 GRANTS>

LAST YEAR, THE CAL-NEV-HA CHILDREN'S
FUND ESTABLISHED THE COVID-19
COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE GRANT
PROGRAM TO ASSIST KIWANIS CLUBS
WITH PROJECTS THAT DIRECTLY
ADDRESS THE URGENT NEEDS OF THEIR
COMMUNITY DUE TO THE COVID-19
PANDEMIC.

DURING THE 2019-2020 ADMINISTRATIVE
