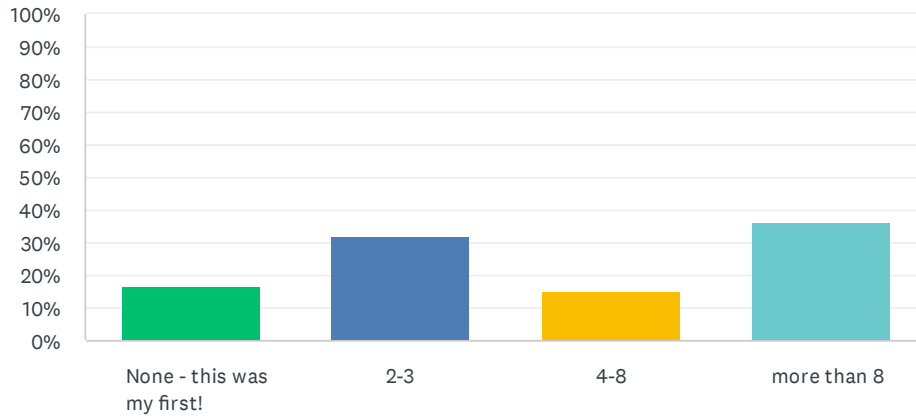


Q1 How many Cal-Nev-Ha Kiwanis Mid-Year Conferences have you attended in the past?

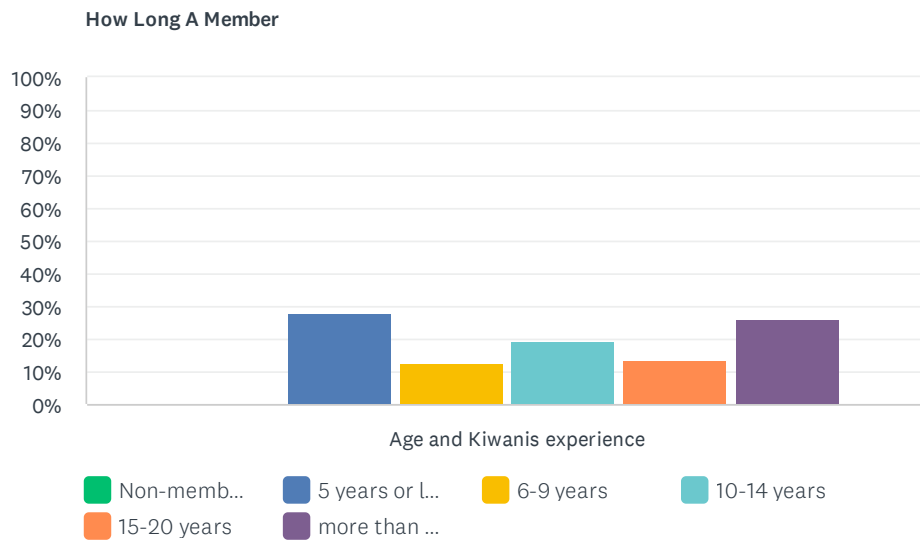
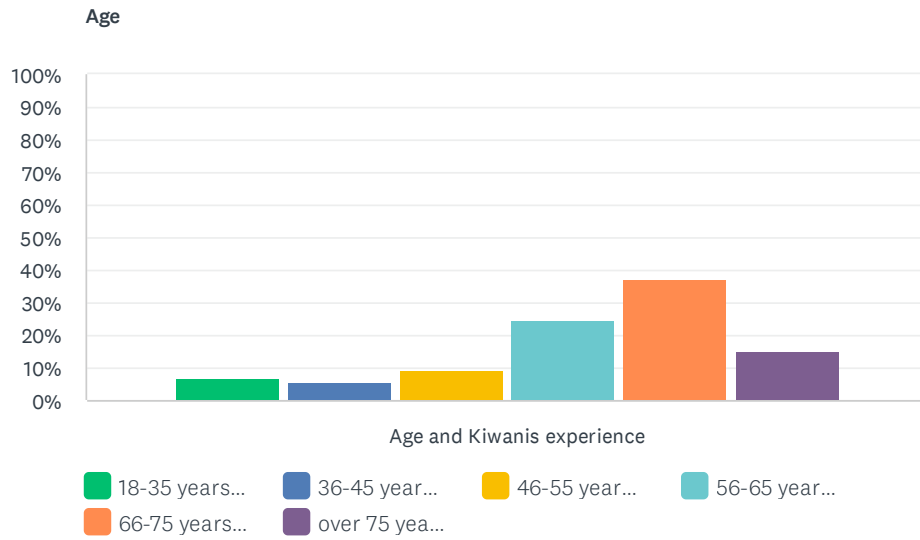
