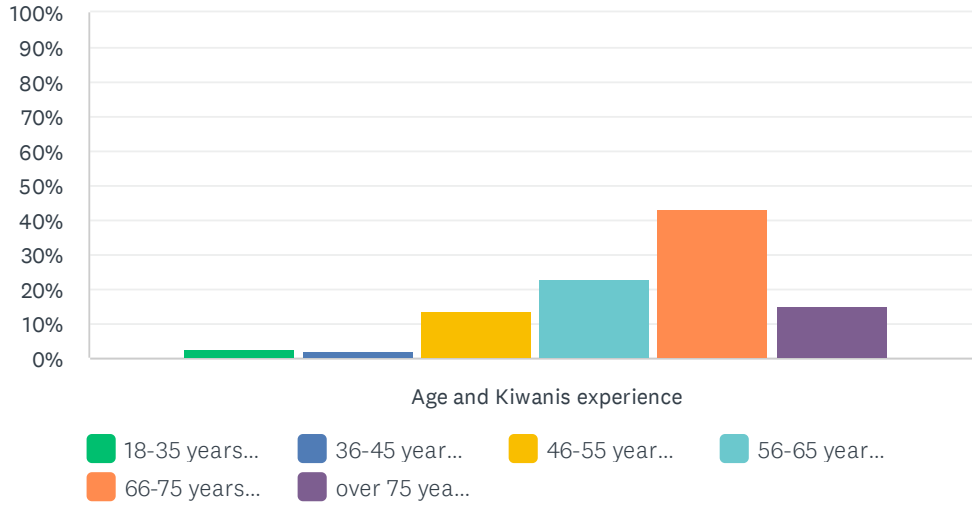

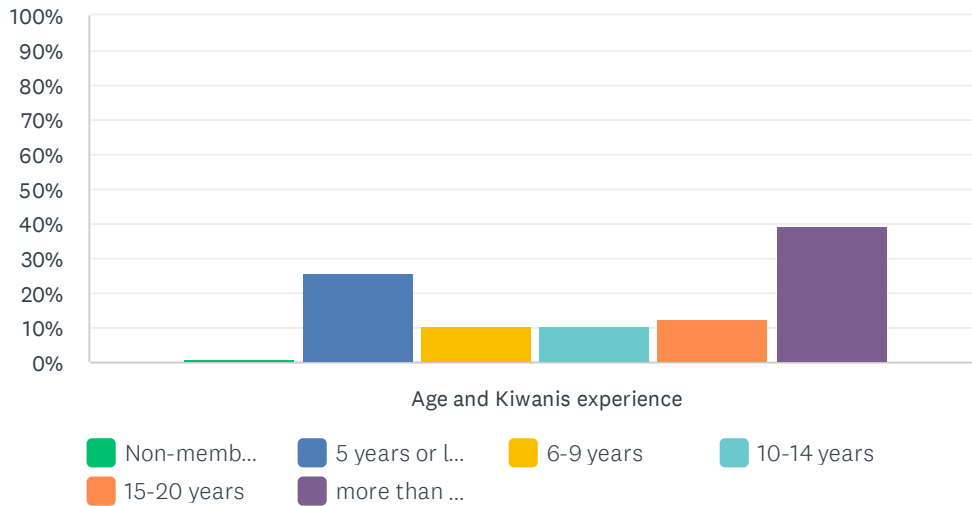

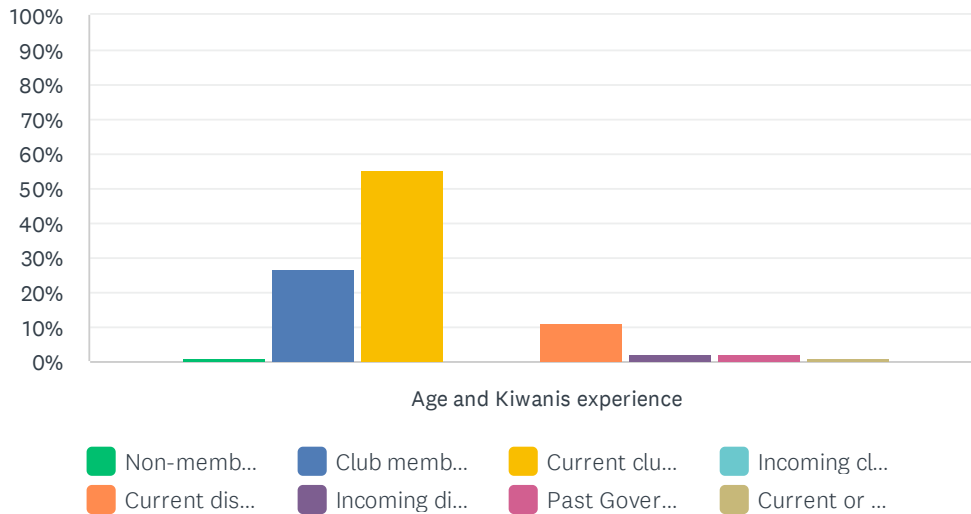
### Age

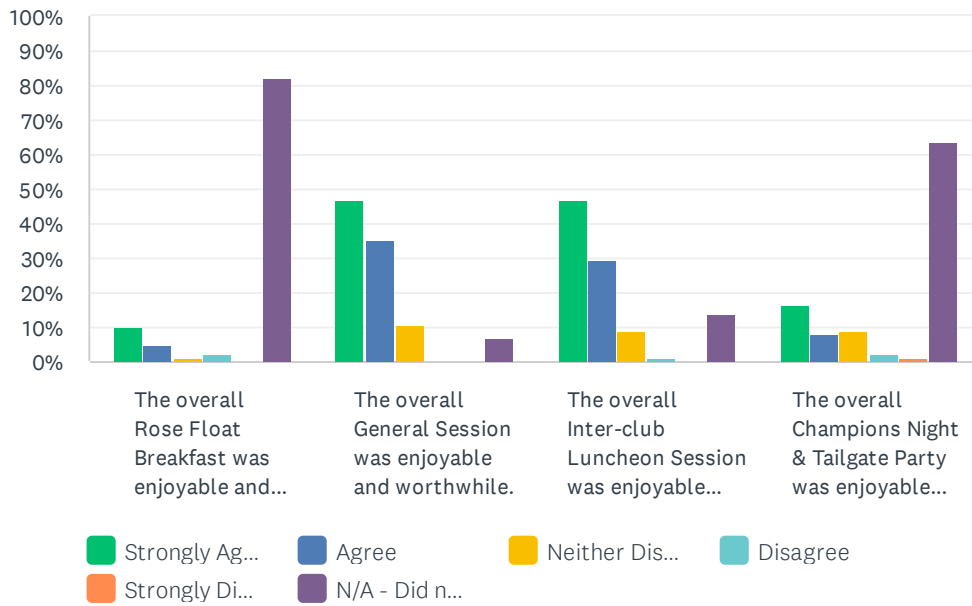

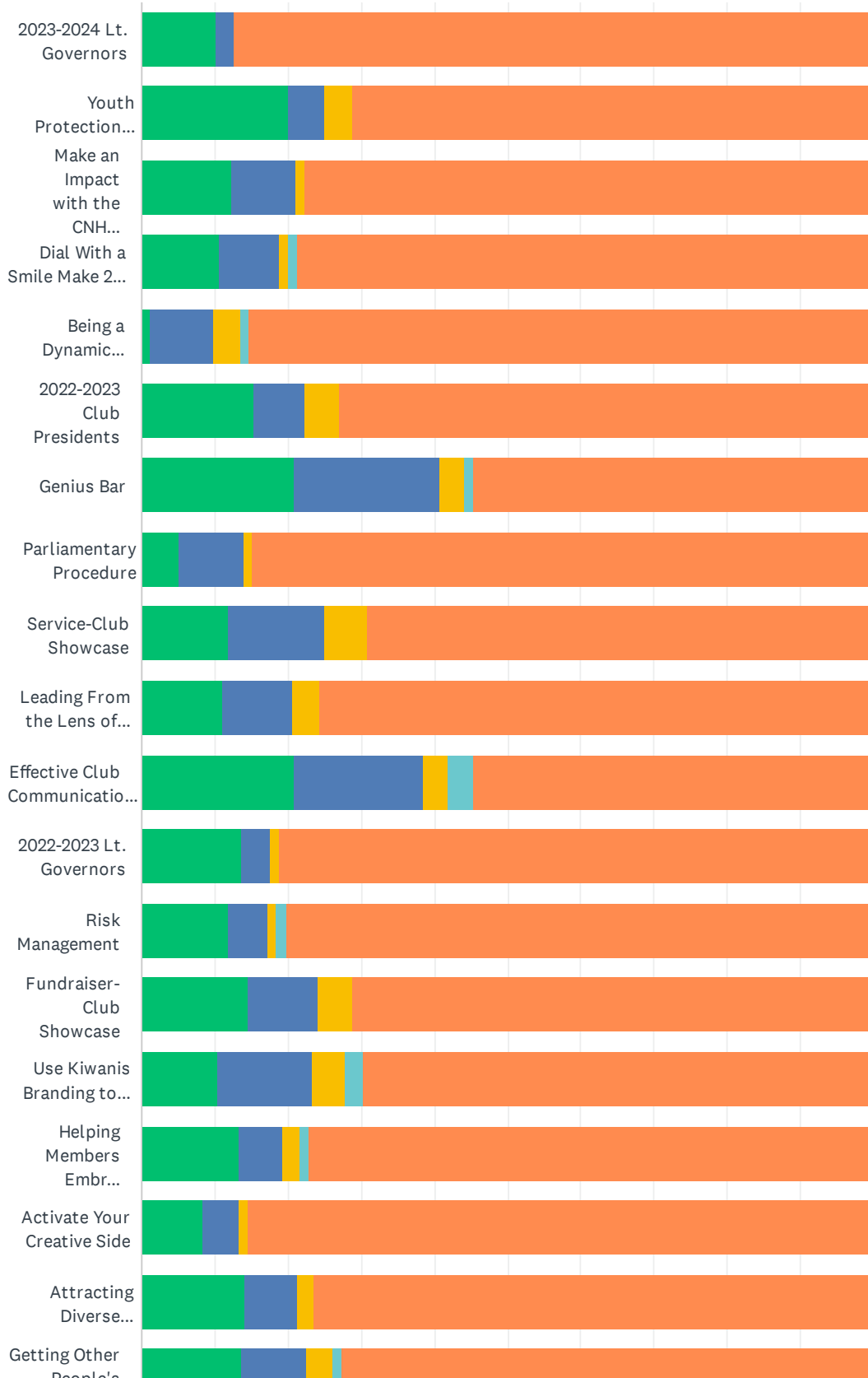

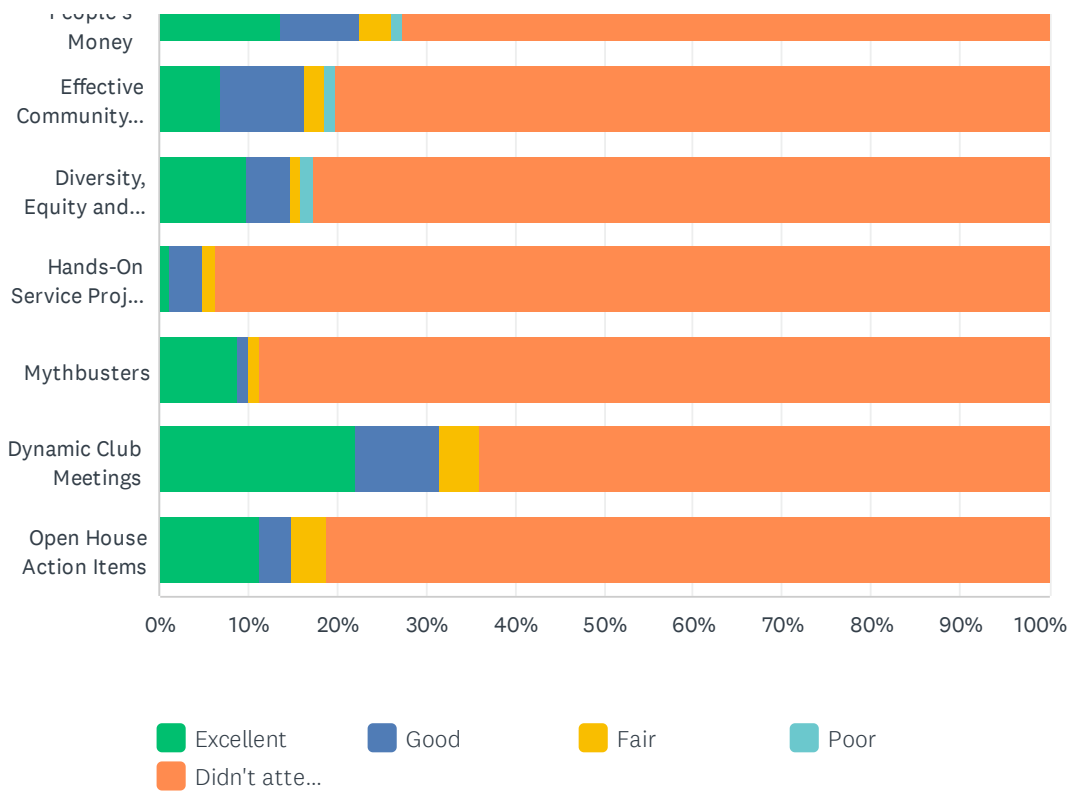
