Q4 How would you rate each Sessions Program?

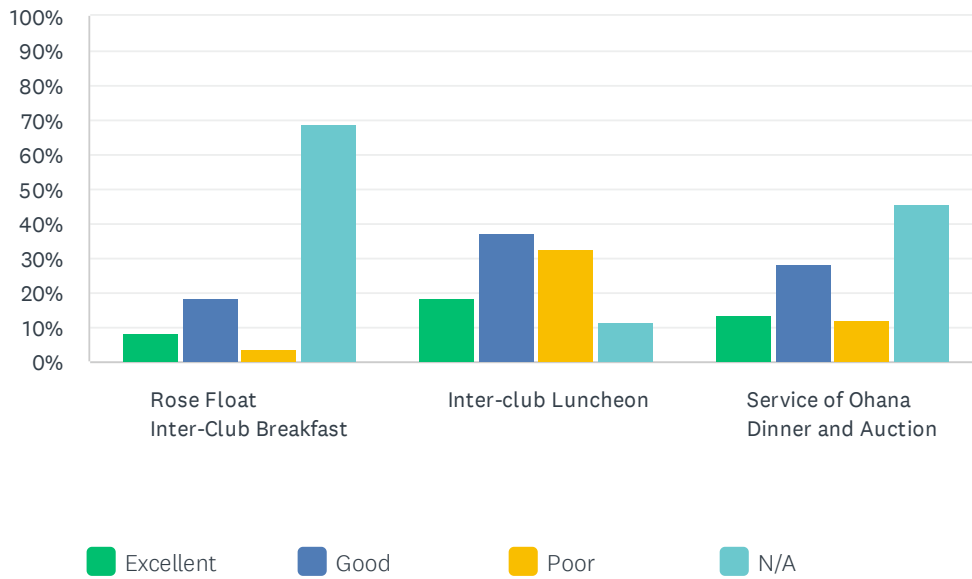

Q5 How would you rate each Sessions Meal?

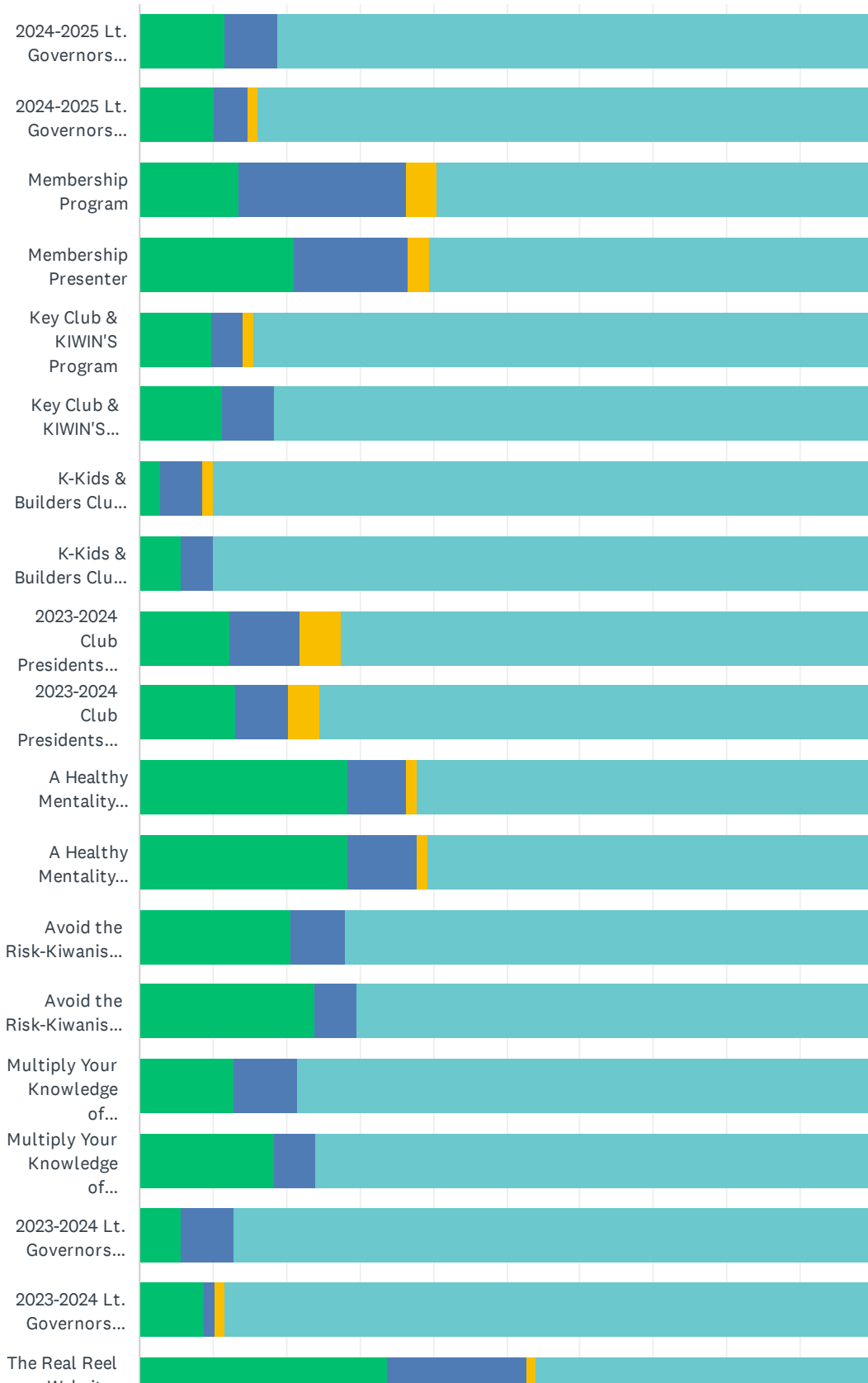

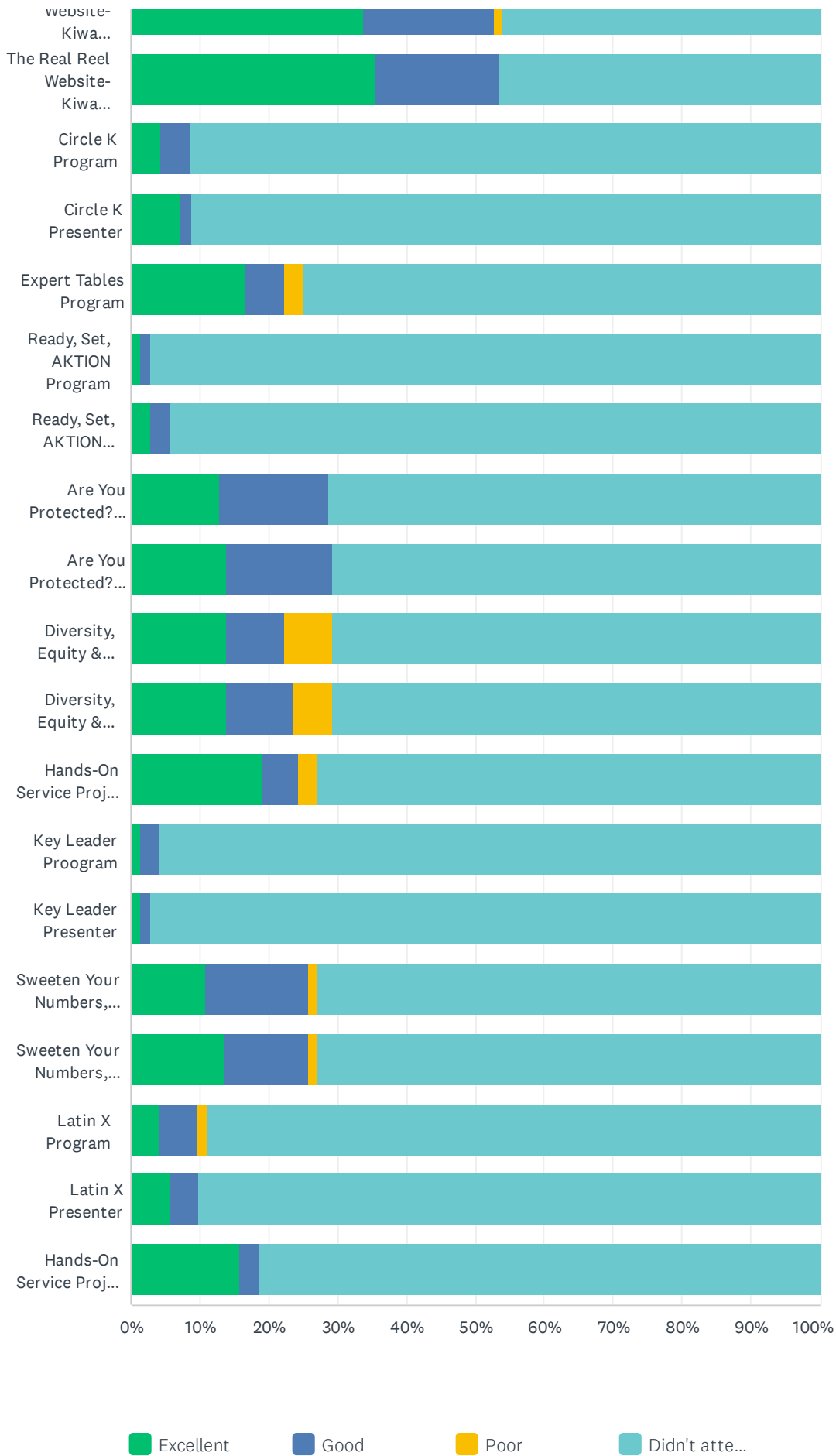

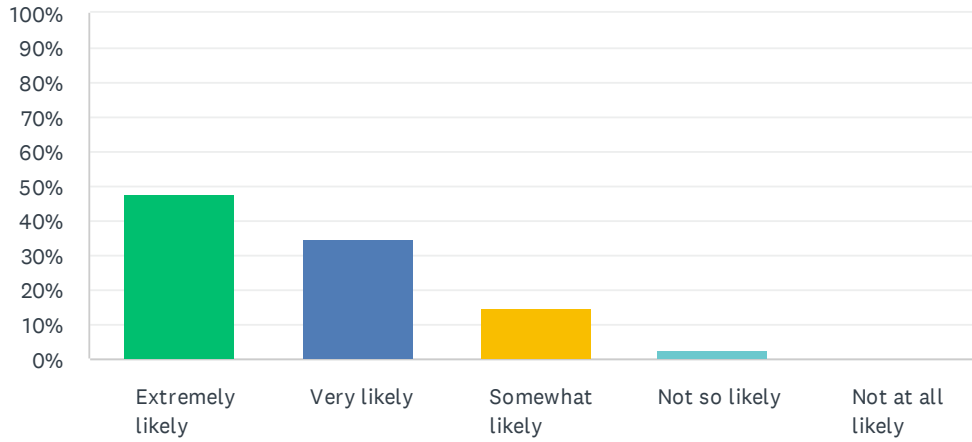
