Q10 Was this your first Cal-Nev-Ha District Convention?





Q11 If this was not your first convention, how many have you attended in the past?






Q13 If yes, is your spouse/partner/guest who attended with you a Kiwanian?

Q17 How would you rate the 2017 District Convention in Sparks?


