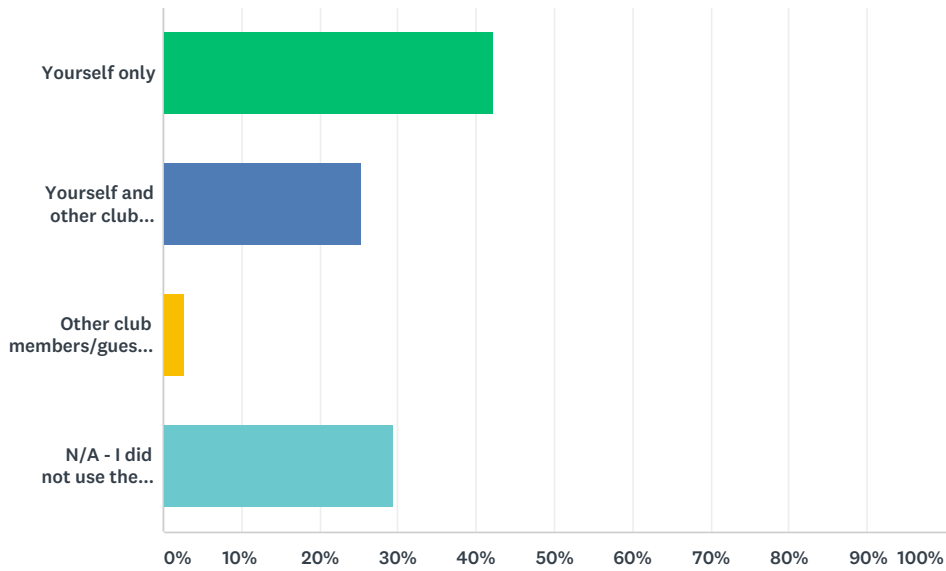

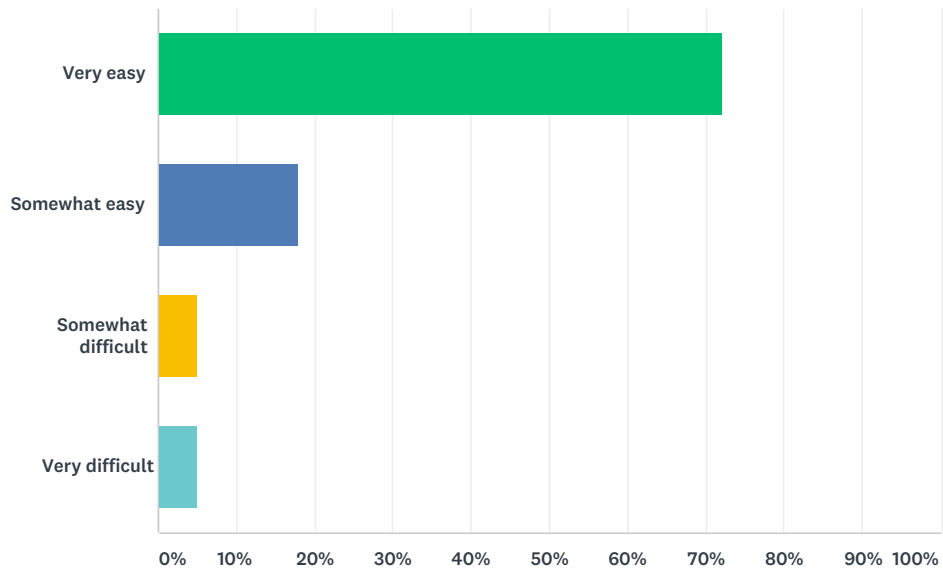

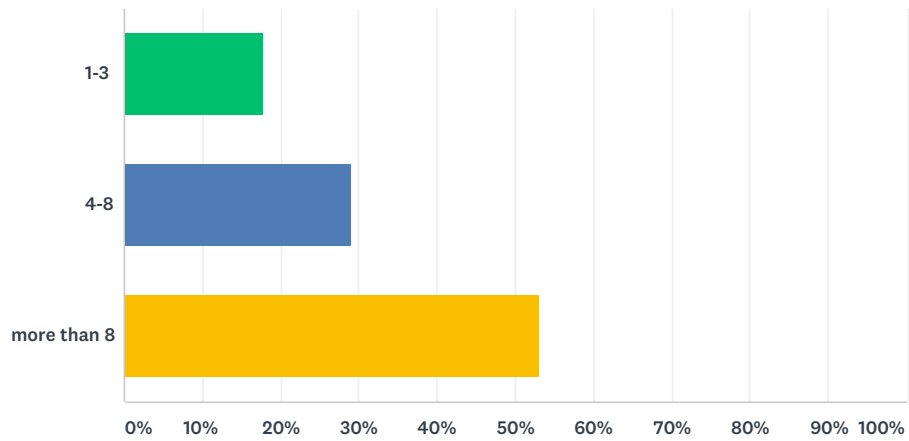

Q6 If this was not your first Mid-Year Conference, how many have you attended in the past?

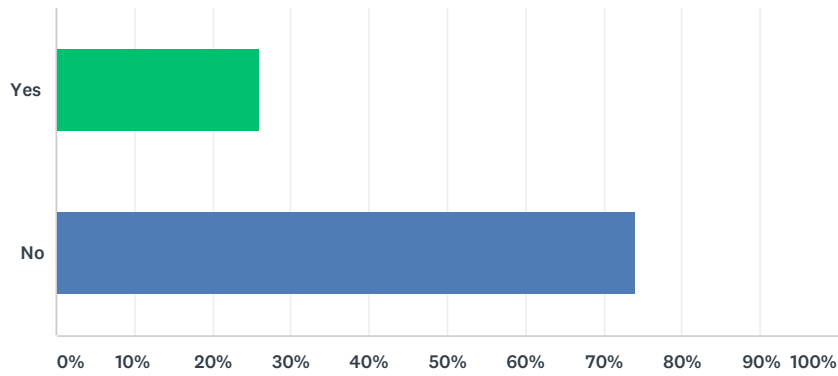

Q7 Did your spouse/partner attend the conference with you?

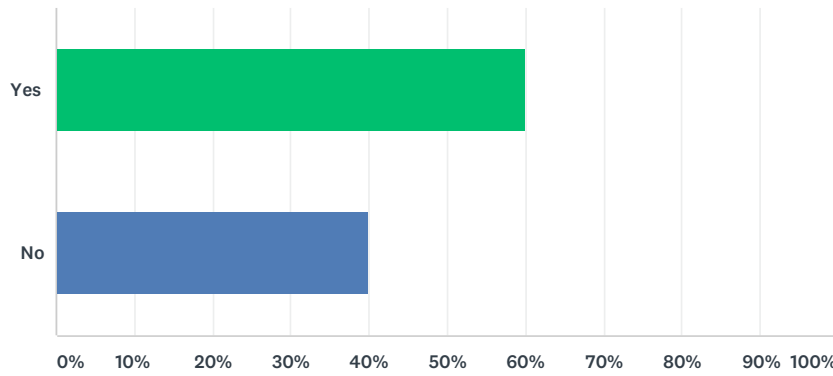

Q8 If yes, is your spouse/partner a Kiwanian?

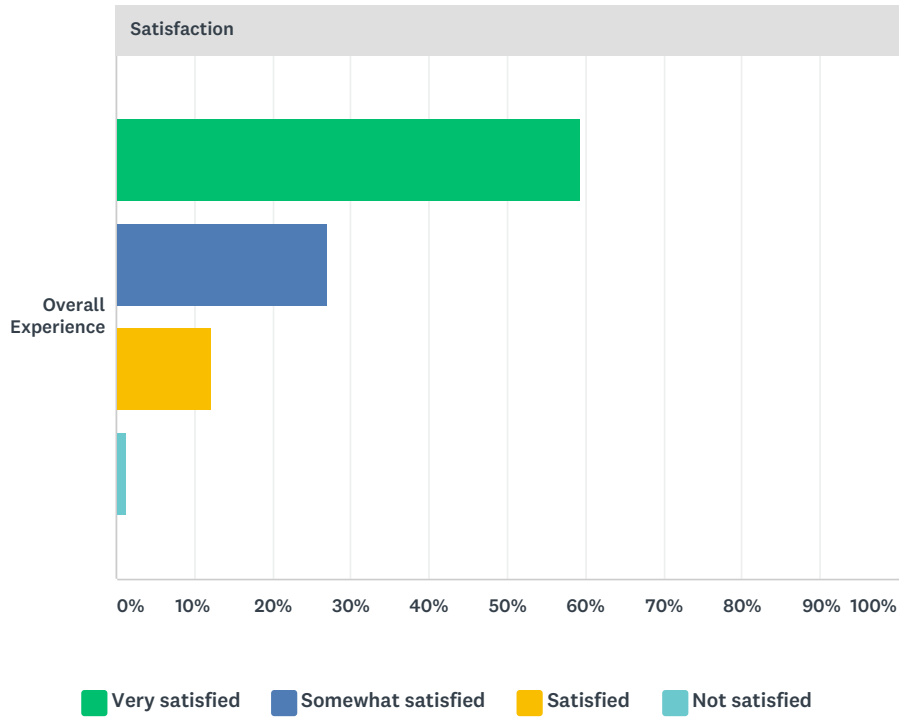

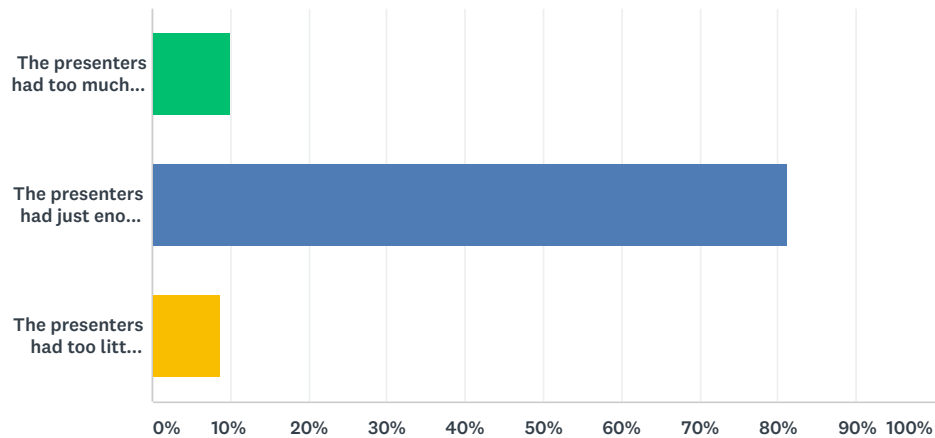
