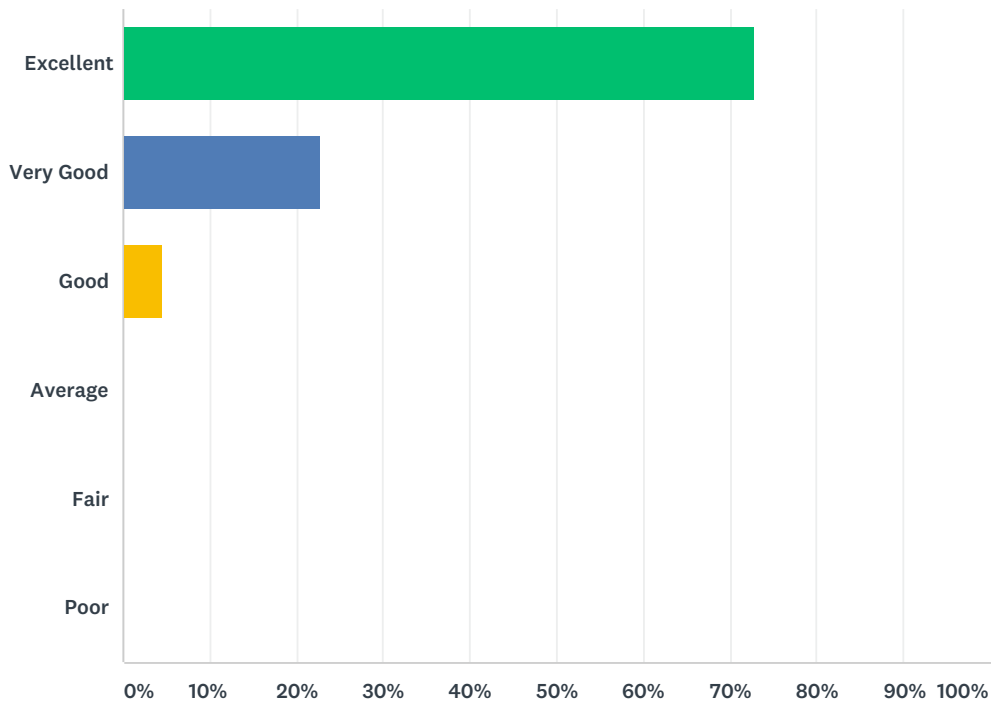


# Q1 How would you rate the overall quality of the Lt. Governor training conference?

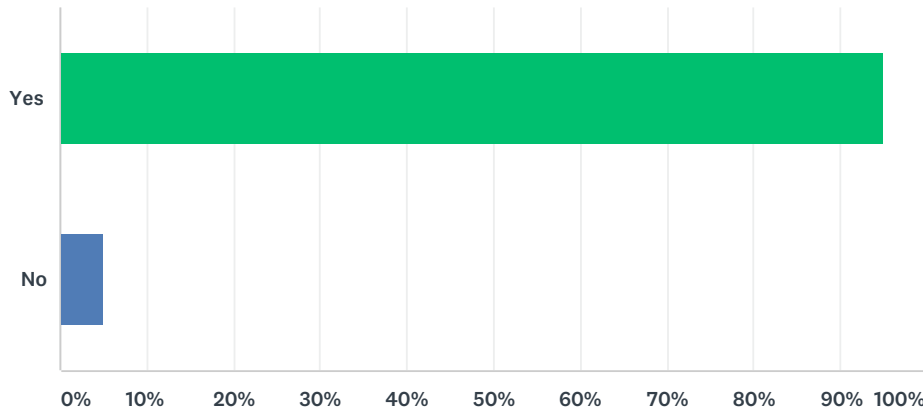
## Q2 What subjects were not covered that you would have liked to have been presented?

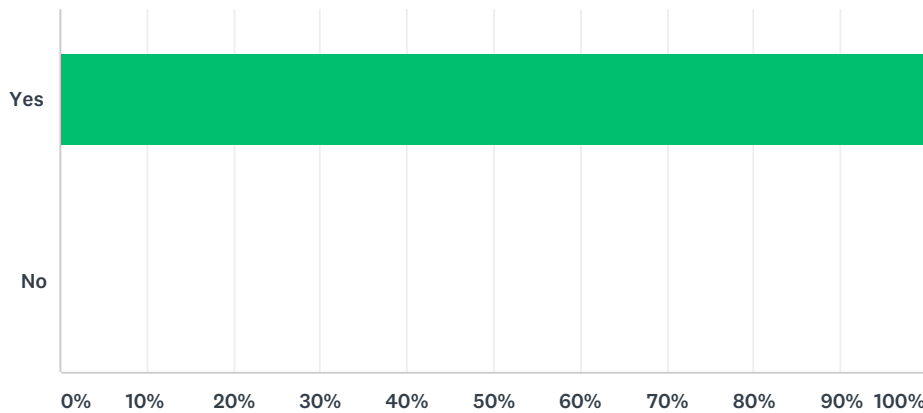

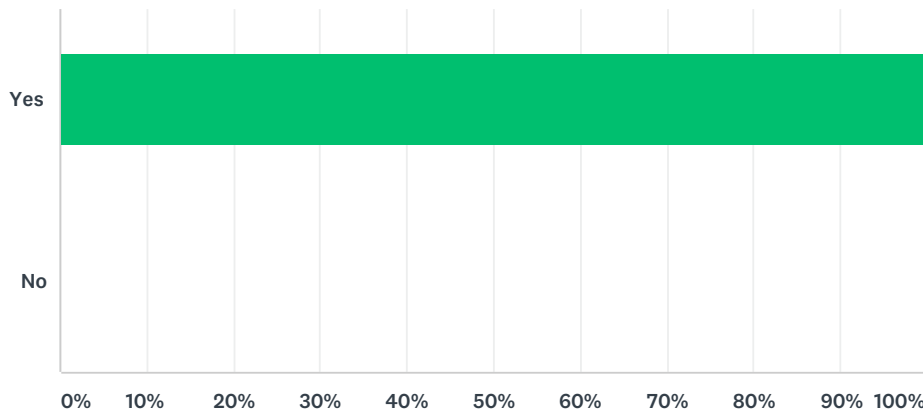
