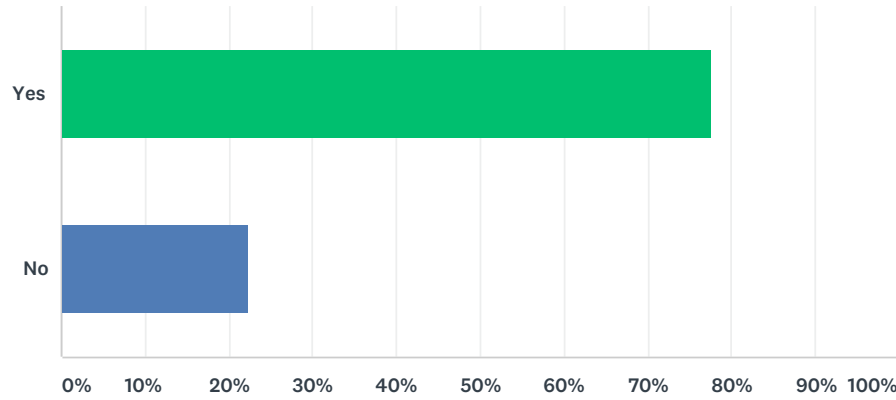

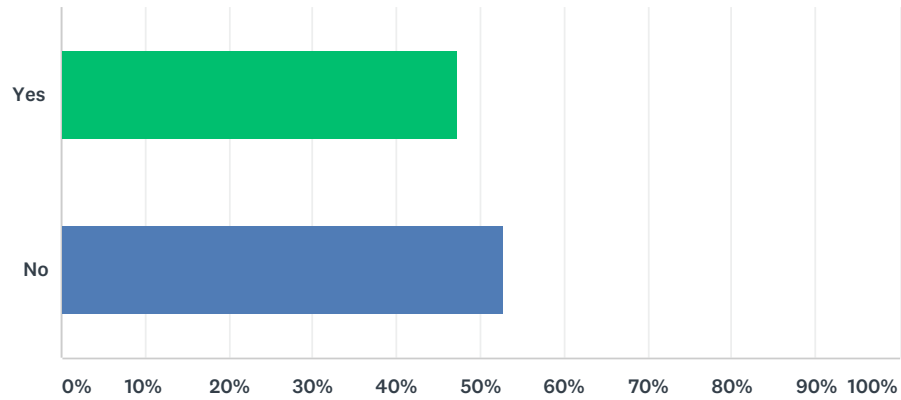

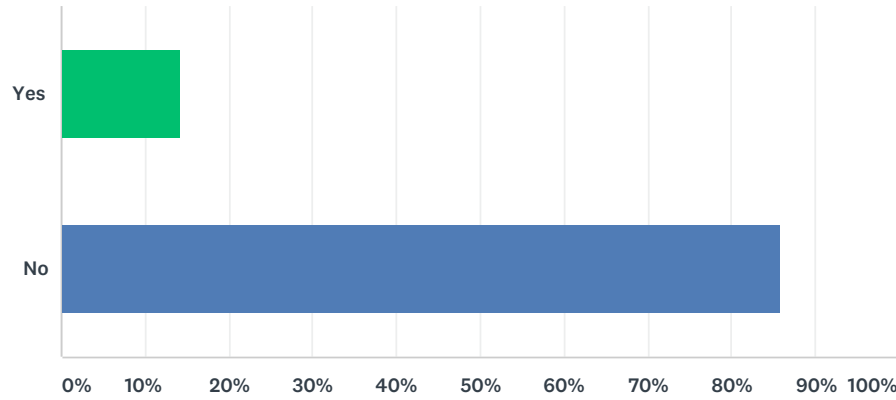

Q9 Was this your first Cal-Nev-Ha District Convention?

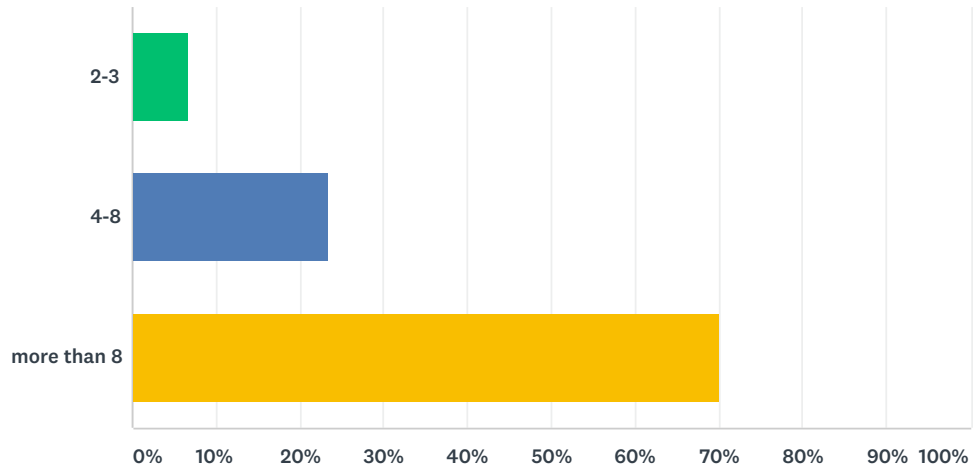

Q10 If this was not your first convention, how many have you attended in the past?

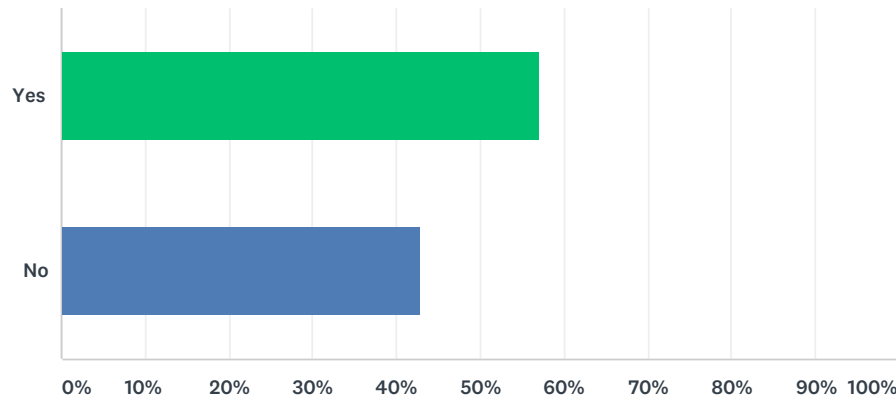

Q11 Did a spouse/partner/other guest attend the convention with you?

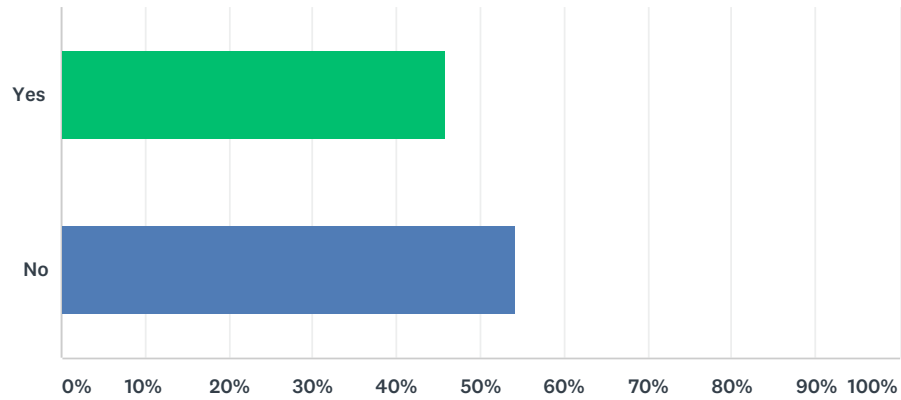

Q12 If yes, is your spouse/partner/guest who attended with you a Kiwanian?

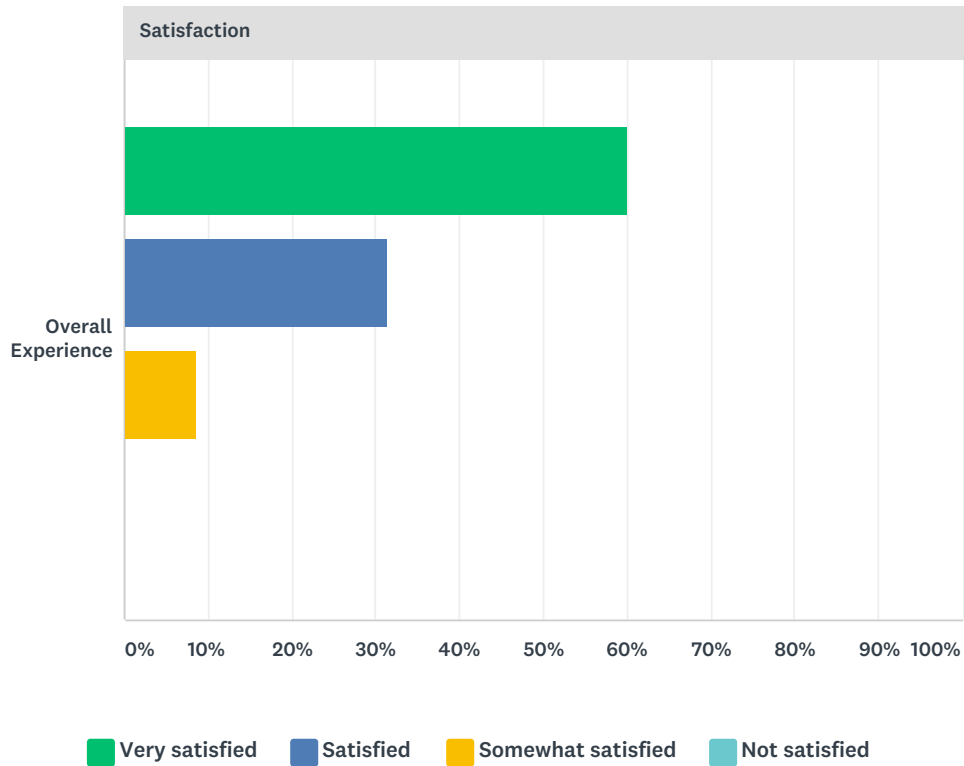

Q13 Overall, how satisfied were you with your convention experience?

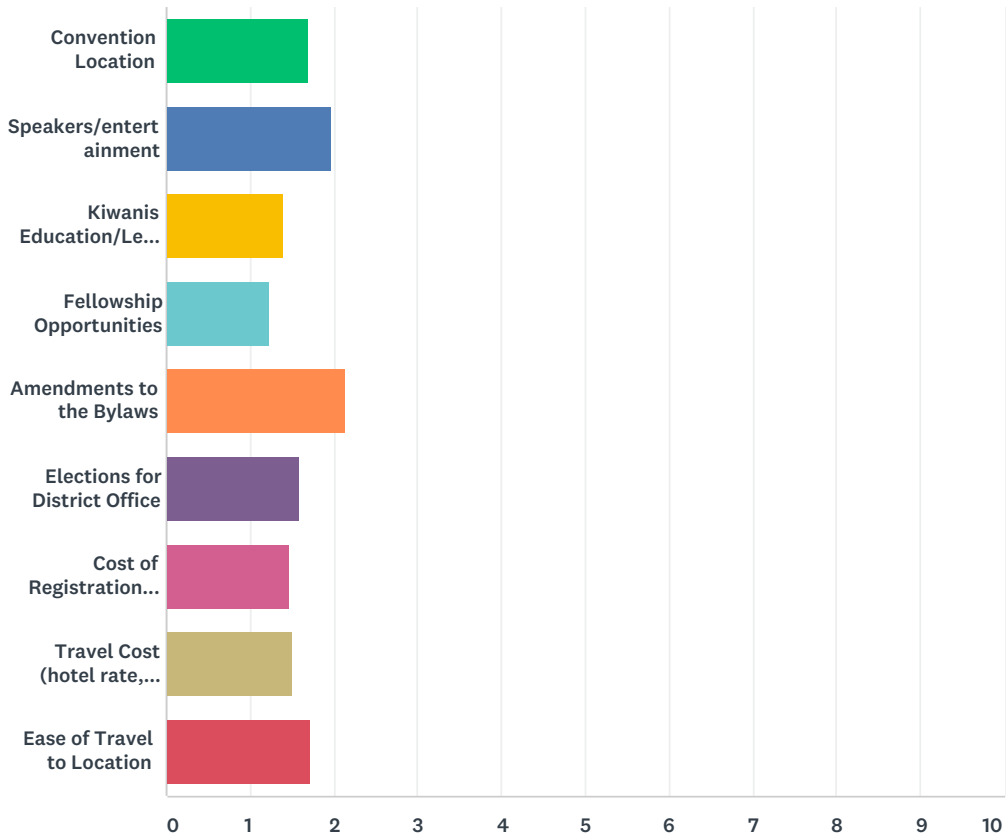
